DES Report:

- 12 Invest, 10 notifications, Hazmat 2 responses, 3 notifications for February
- Locution: working with Hexagon on track for Mid Summer for completion.
- CAD Updates went well, New Firewalls in place. Working to finish up any kinks with the 3rd party vendors.
- MontCo Both Counties can program channels into their respective radios. Will be doing some further testing.
- Fire Digital 1 Interference in the south. ACD did a survey and could not replicate. Going to be doing further testing.
- Sikorsky Helicopters Is Out of Service in the CAD
- New Routers Still in progress. BJ is working with the technical division.

- RTF Structural Collapse Regional Class being held. 8 personnel attending. Rope/High Angle 1 completed.
 Working on a Trench Class. There possibly is some money for a 2nd drone with Thermal Imaging capabilities.
- FTF 4/23 All Hazards Exercise at Philly Fire Academy. Contain Neil Vaughn if interested on being on the Fire Task Force. Looking for input on revitalizing the Fire Task Force. Let us know your ideas. Current idea is a multi alarm fire triggers an Officer Notification for an officer to respond out and work with the OIC if additional Task Force resources are able to assist.
