-Apparatus reports to front entrance -Off. estab. CMND in lobby. Assess alarm panel. Obtain keys -Crew lobby first, then to fire floor for attack -Standpipe connect floor below fire -Driver w/crew estab Lobby Control (elevator, alarm panel, fire systems, mech sys)	-Lay supply line from hydrant to FDC -Driver connect to FDC (standpipe first, then sprinklers if able) -Crew w/ hose and equip to fire floor. -Assist 1st Engine with initial hose line deployment (bring extra hose) -Verify interior staging 2 floors	-Gather hose, tools, cylinders -Crew upstairs to fire floor -Deploy back-up / 2nd hose line (connect 2 floors below) -If line not needed on fire floor, stretch to floor above the fire (can connect on fire floor if safe to do so)	-Ensure reliable, uninterrupted water supply -Crew w/ hose, tools, cylinders upstairs -Assist 3rd Engine with back-up/2nd hose line deployment	-Chief Officer estab accountability in lobby -Crew establishes Lobby Control -Control elevators -Monitor alarm panel -Bldg sys, HVAC -Sprinkler control -Utilities -Manage occupant -Obtain bldg. keys	-Crew with hose, tools, cylinders -Report to Lobby Control for assignment -Can be used to supplement a short-staffed crew
1 st TRUCK	2 nd TRUCK	3 rd TRUCK	EMS	Incident Commander	
-Responsible for all truck company duties on the fire floor -Deposit crew at main entrance/lobby for quick access to interior -Crew with tools, cylinders to fire floor -Position truck/turntable for best use near fire -Ground ladders low flrs	-Responsible for all truck company duties initially on the floor above the fire (then all floors above) -Crew upstairs with tools, cylinders -Position truck for best use opposite side/wing from 1st Aerial -Ground ladder lower floors if needed	-Provides Initial RIT -Appropriate RIT tools, equip, cylinders -Crew upstairs. Stage floor below the fire -Position truck for best use -This crew will be supplemented (<i>not replaced</i>) by RIT/FAST	-Establish EMS Group in lobby (or as directed) -Supply a forward EMS crew upstairs at Interior Staging (2 floors below) -Position ambulances for easy exit	-Performs 360 size-up (if able) -Proceeds to lobby. Assumes Command -Assess fire alarm panel information -Verifies duties of incoming units -Establish an ICS system using NIMS -Command, control, and communications -Establishes Passport Accountability -Develops Incident Action Plan -Establishes ISO and IRIT -Announce stairwells for fire attack / evac. -Transmits benchmarks (water on fire, search complete, fire under control, etc.) -Supports building fire protection systems -Utilizes building pre-plan if available
