

LFD & Regional Structure Fire Assignments (Low-Rise)

1st ENGINE

- Lays supply line
- Proceeds to Side "A" or fire front. Leave room for Ladder
- 360 size-up. Give brief report. Establish Command.
- Stretch initial line to attack the fire (in priority of life safety, stabilization or property conservation)
- Considers supplying

2nd ENGINE

- Proceed to Side "A" or fire front. Ensure 1st Engine has a water supply secured
- Assist 1st Engine with hose deployment, or...
- Stretch 2nd hose line
- Connect to FDC and/or sprinkler if available (150 psi)
- Obtain orders from Command before

3rd ENGINE

- Park out of the way
- Establish Initial RIT at entry point
- Conduct 360, Bring appropriate RIT tools/equipment
- Place Ladders/Bring charged hose line to entry point
- Company Officer is initial Safety Officer
- Perform 360 then

4th ENGINE

- Lays secondary supply line
- Proceeds to Side "C" or opposite fire front
- Leave room for 2nd Ladder
- Stretch water line to Side C or side opposite fire front
- Back-up line or cover interior exposures
- Report findings to IC

5th ENGINE

- Ensure 4th Engine has secured secondary supply line
- Proceeds to Side "C" or opposite fire front
- Protects exposures
- Ensure Connection to FDC and/or sprinkler (150 psi)
- Obtains orders from IC before charging any FDC

1st TRUCK

- Proceeds to Side "A" or fire front
- Position truck for main aerial operation
- Forcible entry if needed, Search and Rescue
- Deploy ground ladders
- Control Utilities

2nd TRUCK

- Crew proceeds to Side "C" or opposite fire front
- Position truck Side C if able for main aerial ops
- Forcible entry if needed
- Search and rescue (secondary or above fire)
- Deploy ground ladders

Incident Commander

- Assume command after transfer report
- Performs 360 size-up
- Verifies assignments of incoming units
- Establish an ICS system using NIMS
- Command, control, and communications
- Establishes Passport Accountability
- Develops Incident Action Plan
- Establishes ISO and IRIT
- Validates / transmits operational mode (offensive, defensive, transitional)
- Transmits benchmarks (water on fire, search complete, fire under control)
- Supports building fire protection systems
- Utilizes building pre-plan if available
- Coordinates with EMS / Establish rehab
