CCFCA Advisory Board Report:

- DES is looking to start the Annual Chiefs Update again. Asking if we prefer a weeknight or a weekend. North preferred a weeknight.
- Stand-by
 - 1 Engine to home station, 911 center gets autonomy to look at the bigger picture for the region.
 - If coverage fails, after 2 attempts to fill it, Dispatcher goes back to OIC on what they would like to do.

- Field Requests for stand-bys will only be requested by the OIC
- No covers of special units (Ladder, Tankers, Rescues) unless the 911 centers sees a void in the region and makes a determination for additional Stand-by units.
- As the OIC if you have a different idea or need for stand-bys please call the Fire Board on the phone and speak with them to work out a plan.
- SMUs Still Out of Service:
 - They thought they had a fix from Harris. They put it in, and the system started sending erroneous status changes to CAD so it's been turned back off. They are still investigating a fix.
- Follow up discussion of raising annual company dues to \$200 for 2026 with a donation to the CCFPA.
- Ops Committee – working on marking condemned structures. May get DES funding for that program.

DES Report: Justin McClure

- Slated to be here in January, still doing interface development with the CAD
- Tax Rebate – County having a public hearing on 11/19, Should be getting all the changes asked for.
- New Stand-By Policy going into effect of 11/11.
- Hazmat: New Hazmat Dispatch Policy going into effect 11/11.
- True Emergency Button Activations - keep an ear open to the Emergency Channel. Had 3 activations last month with EMS needing immediate help for combative patients

FM & HazMat Report: Justin McClure

Old Business:

- Municipal/School District Tax Rebate.
 - Get your municipal tax rebate information to Sly so he can build a database
 - Looking to go to the School Districts
 - Ray is going to approach the OJR Superintendent to see if OJR School Board may entertain.
 - Need to work on your local townships on their property/earned income tax rebates as additional support for when approaching the School Districts.

New Business:

- Thank you Chief Sly CCFCA President for attending the North Meeting.
 - John Sly discussed an effort to make non-life threatening Trees & Wires Calls as Chief Notification as a Default Response. North was in favor of pursuing this effort. Fire companies would still be able to make this an Engine response if they desire
- Joel had a question about the new Haz-Mat Incident Responses for reported gas leaks for anything over a 20lb cylinder. John Sly read the new policy to the group and advised he was not

consulted with that planned change from DES, but said it was in response to a few incidents with larger tanks.

Good of the Company:

- Election of 2026 Officers.
 - Nominating Committee said that no positions were opposed. Ray Kolb (62) made the motion to keep the officers the same for 2026. Secretary will cast the single ballot. Seconded by Jay Pollinger (61). All in Favor.

- Montco Report: This Saturday, MCFCA, 8-4 Beyond Sidewalk Supervision. Limerick Station.
- The Fire Marshals office advised to Try to preserve the scene for the Fire Marshals, especially if suspicious in nature.
- January's Meeting will be at Ludwigs Corner Fire Co. on January 14th.
